# Strengthening Cybersecurity and Compliance for The Myuma Group

The Myuma Group is a Queensland-based conglomerate of not-for-profit corporations established by the Indjalandji-Dhidhanu people. The organisation focuses on creating employment, training, economic and cultural development opportunities for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

Through entities including Myuma Pty Ltd, Rainbow Gateway, Dugalunji Aboriginal Corporation and Indjalandji-Dhidhanu Aboriginal Corporation, the group delivers services across civil construction, road maintenance, mining, hospitality, cultural heritage and land management. Their work plays an important role in supporting local economic development across North-West Queensland.

As the organisation expanded its operations and contractual obligations, strengthening cybersecurity and meeting government compliance standards became a growing priority. For many not-for-profit organisations, balancing strong security with limited internal IT resources can be challenging, particularly when working with government agencies or managing sensitive community data.

## Partnering for Stronger Cybersecurity and Compliance



With evolving contractual requirements and increasing regulatory expectations, Myuma embarked on a cybersecurity transformation program designed to strengthen its security posture and meet the Australian Government's Essential Eight mitigation strategies.

FUJIFILM IT Services partnered with Myuma to guide the organisation through this process, beginning with the implementation of foundational security controls required to achieve **Essential Eight Level 1 compliance**. Having supported a range of community and not-for-profit organisations, the team understood the need for practical, cost-effective security solutions that meet compliance requirements without adding operational complexity.

From there, the engagement evolved to support Myuma's progression toward **Essential Eight Level 2 maturity**, helping to build stronger policies, monitoring capabilities and security practices across the organisation.

Working closely with Myuma's internal team, FUJIFILM IT Services implemented a comprehensive cybersecurity solution that included:

- Application control and endpoint security
- Vulnerability monitoring and patch management
- Managed SIEM and Managed Detection and Response (MDR)
- Immutable backup protection.

The environment incorporated technologies including **ThreatLocker, Microsoft Entra, SentinelOne and Veeam Backup**, creating a layered security framework designed to protect critical systems and sensitive data.

By aligning new technologies with Myuma's existing infrastructure and operational requirements, the solution provided strong coverage of compliance requirements while remaining practical and cost effective for the organisation.



# Immediate Results and Long-Term Impact

Following the implementation of these cybersecurity measures, Myuma achieved a stronger and more resilient security environment while successfully meeting its government compliance obligations.

## 1 Improved Security and Compliance Readiness

The implementation of Essential Eight controls significantly strengthened Myuma’s cybersecurity posture. The organisation now operates with a structured security framework aligned to recognised government standards.

## 2 Stronger Protection of Systems and Data

Advanced monitoring, endpoint security and immutable backups have introduced multiple layers of defence, reducing exposure to cyber threats and improving the organisation’s ability to detect and respond to potential incidents.

## 3 Greater Confidence with Clients and Partners

Meeting government cybersecurity requirements enables Myuma to engage confidently with stakeholders, providing assurance that systems and data are protected to the expected standard.

## 4 New Opportunities for Growth

With a stronger security foundation in place, Myuma is better positioned to pursue government and commercial contracts that require strict adherence to cybersecurity and compliance standards.

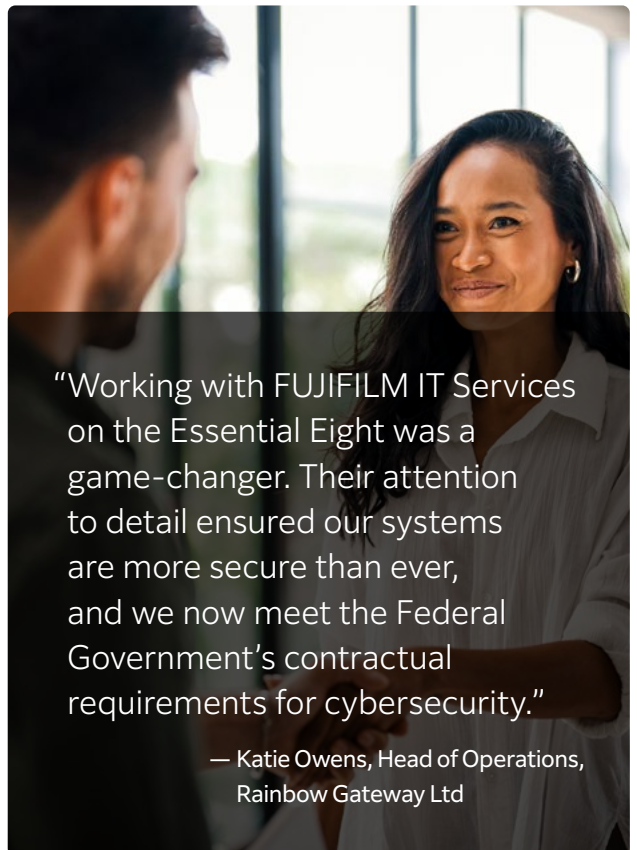
## Ongoing Support and Trusted Partnership
